



COOKIE POLICY

Introduction

This Cookie Policy is drafted and provided as a supplement to the policy published on the website www.laborplast.net (“**Site**”) pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679 and is also made in accordance with the provisions set forth in the measures of the Italian Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data (“*Garante per la Protezione dei Dati Personali*”) no. 229 of May 8, 2014 (“*Identification of the simplified procedures for the provision of information and the acquisition of consent for the use of cookies*”) and no. 231 of June 10, 2021 (“*Cookie Guidelines and other tracking tools*”) and their subsequent amendments and supplements.

The data controller is LABORPLAST S.p.A., with registered office at Via F. Magellano 52, 20020, Magnago (MI) and operational headquarters at Via Massari Marzoli 21, 21052, Busto Arsizio (VA), Fiscal Code and VAT Number 01710340157 (“**LABORPLAST**”).

It is strongly recommended that each user of the Site (“**User**”) consults this document frequently in order to be aware of potential changes or amendments that may be made to it primarily as consequence of regulatory changes.

In the course of browsing the Site, the User may access third-party features or platforms – LABORPLAST is in no way responsible for – that may issue cookies and collect personal data.

What are cookies?

Cookies are usually strings of text that websites (so-called Publishers, or “first parties”) visited by the User or different websites or web servers (so-called “third parties”) place and store – directly, in the case of publishers, and indirectly, *i.e.*, through them, in the case of “third parties” – within a terminal device in the availability of the User himself (*e.g.*, a computer, a tablet, a smartphone, or any other device capable of storing information). Internet browsing software and the operation of these devices, *e.g.*, browsers, can store cookies and then transmit them back to the sites that generated them on a subsequent visit by the same User, thus maintaining memory of his or her previous interaction with one or more websites.

Information encoded in cookies includes, but is not limited to: the type of browser used (*e.g.*, Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox); the domain name from which the User accesses the Internet; the website from which the User reached the Site; and the date and time of access. This information is needed, for example, for more efficient navigation and use of a website or that is necessary to enable certain features, to avoid entering the same information (such as, for example, username and password) at each access, for statistical purposes or for customizing a site according to the User’s preferences.

Why do we use cookies?

The Site uses cookies to facilitate and improve User’s browsing experience (technical cookies), to analyze each User’s use of the Site and collect access statistics (analytical cookies), and/or to ensure that advertising content displayed online is more targeted to the user and their interests (profiling cookies).

What cookies do we use?

Below you may find the types of cookies used by the Site, grouping them according to the purposes for which they are used.

Technical cookies

These are cookies whose purpose is to enable the proper functioning of the Site and/or some of its individual sections and are therefore indispensable to enable the User to fully and correctly navigate the Site and use its functionalities.

These cookies can be either session cookies (*i.e.*, they are automatically deleted whenever the browser is closed) or persistent cookies (*i.e.*, even once the browser is closed, they are not deleted, but persist until a predetermined, pre-set date). Technical cookies are sent by the Site itself (so-called “first-party” cookies) or by third-party domains/websites (so-called “third-party” cookies).

Analytical cookies

Cookies in this category (so-called “analytics cookies” or simply “analytics”) are used to anonymously collect information about the use of the Site.

The Site uses this information to obtain anonymous statistical analysis in order to improve its use and to make content more aligned with Users’ technical needs. Analytical cookies are sent from third-party domains/websites (so-called “third-party” cookies).

Profiling cookies

This type of cookies includes those that are placed on the Site by third parties through the integration of certain features of the Site itself with the platforms/websites of the third parties concerned.

Consent to the installation of cookies belonging to this category is **optional**, and a refusal to do so will in no way affect the proper and smooth operation of the Site.

If, in addition, following activation, you intend to disable one or more of the cookies in this category, please follow the instructions below.

Do I have to accept cookies?

With the exception of technical and/or analytical first-party cookies and/or analytical third-party cookies, which are strictly necessary for normal navigation on the Site, the provision of data is left to the will of the interested party, after having read the brief policy contained in the appropriate banner. The interested party can, therefore, avoid the installation of profiling cookies by closing the banner as well as through the appropriate functions made available in this policy or through their browser.

LABORPLAST, according to the regulations in force, is not obliged to ask for User's consent in relation to the use of technical and/or analytical first-party or third-party cookies, as they are necessary to provide the services requested by browsing the Site. The latter consequently are automatically installed by the Site on User's first visit, except for the possibility for the User to disable them as indicated in the following paragraph. For all other types of cookies, on the other hand, User's consent is requested through an immediate pop-up banner on the Site.

In addition, the User may express or deny consent through one or more of the following ways:

- by accessing and changing the settings of the browser used to browse the Site (in this regard, please refer to the section "**How can I disable cookies?**");

- through changing the settings in the use of third-party services (in this regard, please refer to the section “**How can I disable cookies?**”);
- Through modification of settings as described below.

How can I disable cookies?

Browser options

Almost all Internet browsers are set to automatically accept cookies. The User can change the default configuration and disable cookies by setting the desired level of protection in the appropriate tab. Likewise from the “Internet Options” item of the Tools menu, the “General” tab and clicking on the appropriate delete button. Below you may find more detailed instructions for the User's management of cookies for the most popular browsers. To delete cookies from your smartphone/tablet's Internet browser, you should refer to your device's user manual.

- *Google Chrome*: in the menu select Tools, then Options (Preferences for Mac), go to Advanced and after that select the option Privacy - Content Setting;
- *Mozilla Firefox*: for Mac in the Preferences option, select Privacy, access the “Show cookies” section and for Windows in the Tools section, select Options, access privacy and afterwards configure a custom option for data history; Internet Explorer: in the Tools option, select Internet Options and access Privacy;
- *Safari*: from the Preferences menu, select Privacy;
- *Internet Explorer*: click on the “Tools” button at the top bar of the browser and choose “Internet Options”; click on the “Privacy” tab and in the “Settings” section, change the slider to the desired action for Cookies.

In any case, it is recommended that the User also check, from time to time, the directions of his or her browser.

In the event that the User decides to configure the browser to reject all cookies or reject the essential cookies of the Site, navigation may be slowed down or generate errors.

Third-party policy.

As indicated in the above paragraphs, the Site contains third-party cookies: third parties have their own privacy policy which is different from the one adopted by the Site and with respect to which LABORPLAST is completely unrelated.
